- We recently had a joint youth activity with another church in Rosario, which is an hour away from us. There was a good group of teens involved and they certainly had fun and plenty of food. They also heard a tremendous devotional from one of the recent graduates of the Bible college where I teach.
- In July, during the winter school break, we will be participating in a mini youth camp along with the churches in Rosario. The teens will be taking 3 days to get away and enjoy fun, food, and fellowship together while getting a good dose of the word of God as well. I will be bringing some of the lessons this year and am looking forward to interacting with the youth.
- Recently, I was hearing from a new missionary here that came from Mexico to work with the Jewish population in Rosario. His family has been here only a couple of months but he and his wife are already experiencing the general apathy towards the gospel that is so prevalent in the culture here. I pray that they will stick it out. So many leave during or at the end of their first term here.
- A few weeks ago the majority of my family including myself had to go through the process of renewing our passports at the U.S. Embassy. We had to spend the previous night in Buenos Aires in order to be present the next morning bright and early. Thank the Lord this time everything went very smoothly and we now have new passports. As we were preparing to leave the facility my youngest, Miriam, walked back to where the Vice Consul was and thanked him for being so nice and patient with us! You should have seen the smile on his face as she made his day!
