Dear Prayer Partners

Greetings from Lusaka, we trust that you are well. I can report that the Chilando family all seven of us are doing well. We have just entered the cold season and it's a brisk 55 degrees and wet day. This is very unusual weather for Zambia.



The church got robbed! They took off with offering plates, flower arrangements, vases and baskets. That's about \$350 worth. For a church that averages \$40 a week in offerings that's a lot. Hey, if The Lord's getting "it done" the devil will try to disrupt the work of the church.

The Lord has been hard at work in Lusaka. We are growing in number every Sunday. We have seen over 18 salvations, 20 baptisms and 26 members added to the body. Our church membership has gone from 21 to 57. Though we don't glory in numbers, they give us an insight of what God is doing through His people.

I have witnessed **two personal victories** that Lord has used to encourage me. Two young adults that I have spent countless hours in Bible study finally realized their need for a savior and followed Him in believer's baptism. Praise The Lord.

We have also started the, "**Ignite Student Ministry**" at the Health College. It's a bible study group that is taking the gospel on this college campus. I currently have a class of 20 young people coming to hear the gospel. I recently had the opportunity of leading to the Lord and baptizing – Mpheza. She is the first female student from this college I've had the privilege to baptize. Praise The Lord.

We also had the opportunity of taking 13 young people to a **youth camp in Livingstone**. One young person (Collins) trusted Christ as his savior and three surrendered to serve the Lord in full time ministry. It was an exciting week for them which started with a 25 hour train ride. The train system is not very efficient. However it was worth it. Praise The Lord.

Our furlough departure has had to be adjusted, due to several circumstances. We need a couple months to process Caroline's visa and **we still need to raise about \$4000 dollars** to purchase all the tickets. We are now hoping to leave end of July or early August. Special thanks to **Lighthouse Indian BC** and **Southside BC** for your generous love offerings.

We already have **mission conferences** booked for the fall, but we still have a few more dates to fill. If you would like for us to come and present or update please let us know. Thank you for your prayers and support.
